3-D Archery Schedule

Throughout this coming year, we will purchase new targets and develop new shooting lanes to complement those lanes already in place. We will also be designing a walk through course. We have decided to hold all shoots on Sunday, and the dates are as follows; Feb. 29, Mar. 14, Apr. 18, May 16, Jun. 6, Jul. 10 & 11, Aug. 8, Sep. 11 & 12 and Oct. 18. Cost per shoot is \$7.00 for everyone 16 years and older. Shooters 15 and under will shoot free of charge. Awards will be given in classes with a minimum of 5 shooters.
